NORBERT GREGOR SUCHANEK

Biography

Norbert Suchanek was born in 1963 in Würzburg in Germany. He is an investigative environmental, human rights, and science journalist, author, photographer, awardwinning documentary filmmaker and poet. Since 2006 he lives as foreign correspondent and filmmaker in Rio de Janeiro.

After studying technical chemistry, military service and working for a pharmaceutical company in Munich and Houston Texas, he began his journalistic career in 1987 by



hitchhiking seven months across Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Bolivia, and French Guiana. One of his first published reports dealt with rainforest destruction in the Brazilian Amazon, which remains one of his main focuses.

Later, he researched the conflict regions of Northern Ireland, Palestine, and West Papua/ Papua New Guinea and worked part-time for NGOs such as Greenpeace, focusing on ecology, preserving the rainforest, and indigenous peoples. During this time in the 1990s, he became friends with the ethnobotanist and indigenous rights activist Darrell Addison Posey and worked with him on several reports in German publications.

Over the past nearly 40 years of his work, Norbert's articles, reports and photos have appeared in dozens of newspapers, magazines, and other media outlets in German, English, Portuguese, and Spanish. His investigative reports and books influenced scholars, students, and activists. The seven short documentaries he produced up to 2020 have been selected by over 20 international film festivals and won four international awards. In addition, his award-winning early poems were published in the book "Erinnerung an Licht".


Together with social scientist Márcia Gomes de Oliveira, he founded the International Uranium Film Festival (IUFF) in 2010, which was held for the first time in Rio de Janeiro in May, 2011. To date, they have organized over 80 international uranium film festivals in nine countries, including Brazil, Germany, India, Portugal, and the USA. In October 2024, MovieMaker Magazine in Hollywood selected the IUFF as one of the "25 Coolest Film Festivals in the World 2024." And in March 2025, Norbert and Márcia accepted the Nuclear-Free Future Award in New York City.


