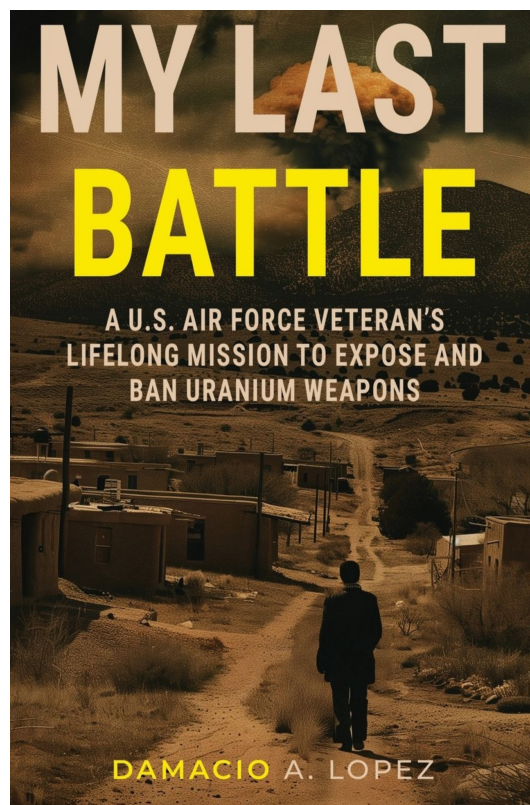

Renowned Polish film director, screenwriter, producer, poet, novelist and painter Lech Majewski pays tribute to a new book on depleted uranium weapons.

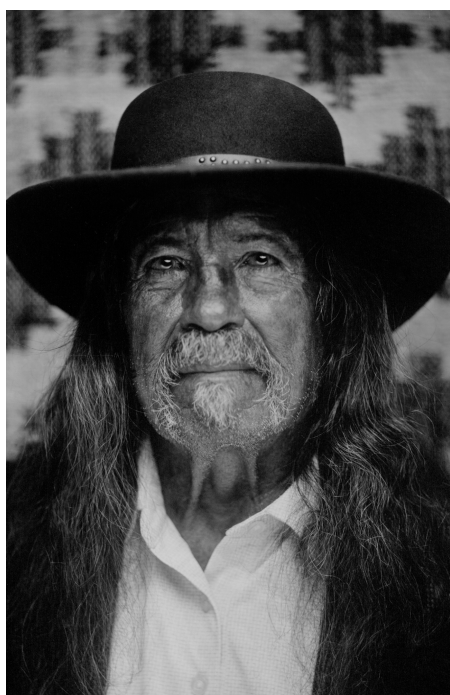

The author, Damacio A. Lopez, is a researcher, activist, veteran and writer from New Mexico. Born in Socorro in 1943, just 38 miles from "Ground Zero" of the world's first atomic bomb detonation, he served in the United States Air Force during the 1962 Cuban Missile Crisis. When he returned to his native town he discovered that depleted uranium munitions were actively being tested at a firing range near his home, resulting in serious health consequences for his community and family. Since then, Lopez spent decades investigating the human and environmental impact of uranium weapons, and has become one of the

most prominent activists campaigning for a global ban on these weapons. In 2025 he received the Honorary Lifetime Achievement Award from the International Uranium Film Festival. „My Last Battle: A U.S. Air Force Veteran's Lifelong Mission to Expose and Ban Uranium Weapons“ is his legacy to mankind.
